

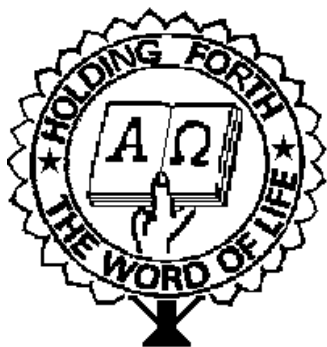

<p><b>Q: What is the misery of that estate whereinto man fell?</b>  <i>A: All mankind by their fall lost communion with God, are under his wrath and curse, and so made liable to <u>all miseries in this life</u>, to death itself, and to the pains of <u>hell</u> for ever.</i></p> <p><u>Comments:</u>                      We are here taught the extent of the misery which has come upon us through Adam's sin.
