THE CV OF A GODLY WOMAN

(PROVERBS 31)

Adapted from Maranatha Messenger, Sunday 21st August 2016

1. Virtue in Character

A redeemed person with a morally undefiled character is a prerequisite when we choose a husband or wife. Ethical infidelity and unfaithfulness are intolerable in any marital relationship and a heterosexual and monogamous one is biblically sanctioned. The marriage vows have to be jealously observed and kept with all our hearts. How many homes have been wrecked by brokenness and unhappiness because of sin and the wiles in this world. Beware of the subtle temptation of the world and the evil one (2 Timothy 2:22). Flee youthful lusts and pursue after righteousness. Virtue encompasses all moral goodness and the sanctified Christian strives to live above reproach, blameless in a crooked and perverse generation.

2. Heart Work and Diligence (v 13-15, 18-22)

One of the greatest joys and benefits of marriage is having an industrious and disciplined spouse. There is nothing like seeing the home spick and span or a cooked meal, clean floor and well-ironed clothes. As for the husband, he works hard to support the family and helps to repair things in the home, beautify the place, teach the children the Word of God and set an example of industry for them to follow. The spouse here in Proverbs 31:12-15, rises up early, works diligently with her hands. She is energetic and zealous of good works and she labours tirelessly everyday for the home and her Lord. She is not idle (V27) and there is a great curse for the slothful.

3. Wisdom and Godly Discretion (v16)

She considers a field or possible investment with her resources and then buys it. She is patiently prudent and discreet and has a good sense of judgement. This is important as a kind of spiritual and practical wisdom in life is necessary. Wisdom comes with the fear of God (Psalm 111:10) and by prayer (James 1:5). A man or woman is thoroughly blessed when he / she has a wise and judicious spouse. Wisdom can be acquired through the Word of God. In v25, she opened her mouth with wisdom. The choice of words like what Nabal's wife Abigail did to avert bloodshed by David from killing her husband. Herein is wisdom as careful and soft words can turn away wrath (Proverbs 15:1).

4. Companionship and Kindness (w 20, 26)

She shows kindness and love to the needy and strangers and poor and there is a law of love and tenderness in her heart. This is important as she will also impart this to the children and this work of Christian hospitality in our homes will bless many saints and strangers. We are told in Romans 12:13, 14, *'Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.'* She enhances the good reputation of her husband that he is well regarded by others (v23). Do you bring shame and dishonour to your spouses or a good report and testimony to him? Be a blessing to others, be careful with your words, actions, conduct that will influence the good name of God, your husband and God's family.

5. Love and Fear of God and His Word (v30)

Finally, the most important quality of a good spouse is that she is redeemed and justified and has the reverence and fear for God. This is evident in her conduct and desires. The fear of God is clean and it brings joy, blessing and prosperity to the home. It keeps them from sin and the moral pollution of the world. It is something that we are to cultivate according to 2 Corinthians 7:1, *'Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.'*

Conclusion

The measure of happiness in a Christian home is directly proportional to the godliness of both spouses with or without the children. The closer we are to Christ, the closer we will be as a family. Every believer should strive to develop and nurture the fruit of the Spirit, good Christian character and demeanour both at home and the office / school. Let us seek the wisdom of Christ and endeavour to build up good Christian attributes in ourselves and others through the sanctification by the Spirit of God.
