FRESH LIVING WATER FROM HIGH HILLS

Just when we taught that we are safe after many global incidents we were faced with another fiasco on CrowdStrike and IT outage recently. Daily, we face threats of wars, economic crisis, political instability, job security (rather insecurity), robbery and sickness plus countless other uncertainties. Mankind is proud that we have achieved tremendous progress through our hard work and intelligence but however capable we maybe we are unable to control the weather and any other "unforeseen happenings". We forget that it is God who gave the increase in our inventions of modern amenities and facilities to enable us to live a more comfortable life.

Worrying and stress over what comes in future is not a new issue. Adam and Eve had the same problems too after they fell into sin. David in writing Psalm 120 faced extreme pressures from all sides of his life. He was in distress and desired a solution to get him out of the rut. David found peace and assurance from God and that is why he penned Psalm 121. He was grateful that he found out and realized that only God has the answer to his strains in life. We do not know what will happen tomorrow, but we know who holds the future. Nothing happens unless God allows it to. The Lord is never out of control. We can rely on Him and Him alone.

Psalm 121 starts with a very comforting verse. When David (and we too) was in trouble he looked unto the hills and found help which comes no other than from the LORD Himself (V2). Nobody can assure you that you would have protection day and night. Humans need rest, machinery need to stop for maintenance (the latest global IT glitch for example). God never sleeps and is forever taking care of us.

V3-4 tell us that He will protect us when we move or whichever way we travel or from whatever condition that we are caught in. Who can give you this promise but God. It is a one sided covenant that God will forever honour because they are His Word. He is with us regardless of night or day. We are "weather-proof" because He will protect us in sunshine or in the shade. This is genuine assurance. When we hold His hands, we may slip because we will be tired at some point of time. When God holds our hands, we will never slip away because He is the Almighty. No harm can come in between God and us. John 10:28 *And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand*.

At best, human can guard us from visible matters. We live in a sinful world of darkness of which many things are beyond what we can see with our eyes. Evil and invisible beings lurk everywhere. Many have not heard or know the existence of the "dark web", an underground network of hackers and those carrying out clandestine operations and often wreaking havoc to the society at large. The dark web is not on the same platform as the normal internet or the web that we use. We are no match for these invisible stuff or beings because what we are only finite. Only God can protect us from the unseens and the invisibles. He is the Creator. Nothing escapes His eyes and control. Fresh in our minds is the global pandemic. Everyone lived in fear of the dreadful virus that we can only see with powerful magnification. The brightest brains were only able to guess how far the infection will be. Yes, we invented vaccination. How effective is it? Did this stop the virus from causing further harm? Humanly, to this day nobody can tell exactly what stopped the virus on its track. However, we know for certain that it is the hand of the Lord which restored the world to normalcy.

Most important of all God preserves our soul. Eventually our pilgrimage on earth will end and what lives on is our soul. God is more concern that we have fellowship with Him forever in Heaven when our souls return to Him. He is such a Great God! It is only right that we acknowledge Him and submit to Him. While He is the Almighty He cares for His saints. Are you one of His saints? If not, come to accept Jesus Christ as your Saviour and be counted as a saint.

V8 The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.
